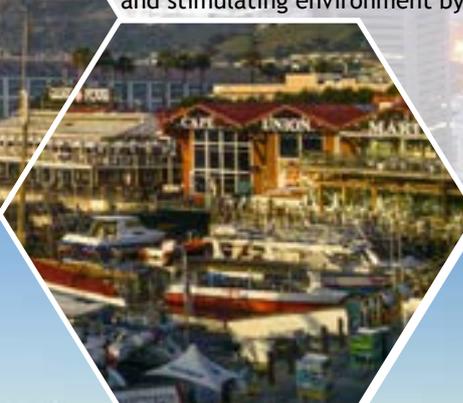


A Creative “Laboratory” for Collaborative Exchange

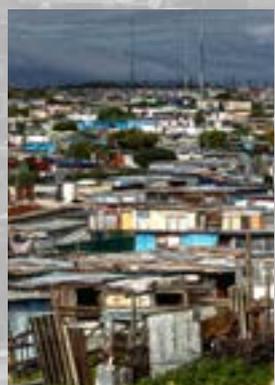


IN THE MIDDLE OF CAPE TOWN'S TOWN SHIP

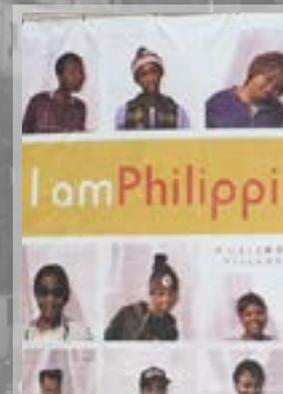


One of Cape Town's largest and poorest suburbs

With more than 190.000 inhabitants living together in cramped conditions, Philippi is one of Cape Town's largest townships and the city's poorest suburb suffering from one of the highest AIDS infection rates (>30%) in South Africa. For tourists, it is not recommended to visit Philippi township without professional guidance or local counselling.

The University of Cape Town's satellite campus „Philippi Village“

In 2015, the University of Cape Town built a satellite campus on the site of a derelict cement factory in the middle of Philippi which soon became a rising hub of education, enterprise, activity and entrepreneurship as well as a prospering business center, offering unprecedented opportunities to some of the most underprivileged of South Africa's society.
